### COLLECTION UPDATES

#### Casey Adams Collection, by Bob Kelley

The photo collection of well known rail photographer Casey Adams has arrived at PNRA. Consisting of approximately 2000 black and white negatives and 5000 slides, the subjects include Great Northern, Northern Pacific, Milwaukee, Spokane Portland & Seattle, Canadian lines, Burlington Northern, and some eastern lines.

Sorting and arranging the materials has just begun. In addition to Adams' own work, he was a very active trader of negatives and several well know photographers are included. The earliest views identified so far are in Minot, North Dakota in the 1940s.

#### George Bergson Donation, by Kurt Armbruster

In June, George Bergson, of Penticton, BC, donated four boxes of his longtime Northwest railroads collection to Archive. His photos of Milwaukee Road and other depots, BN/BNSF equipment and operations, and articles and documents covering various regional railroad issues

will make a valuable addition to the PNRA collections. Thank you, George!

#### Al Haij Collection, by Mike Bergman

Al Haij was a Southern Pacific employee in the Portland area who was a prolific railroad photographer starting in the 1940s. Mike Bergman reviewed a sample of his color slides and found 61 images of Portland Traction Co. interurbans and streetcars, 43 images of interurbans and streetcars of the British Columbia Electric Railway Co., and 43 images of the electric locomotives and other rolling stock of the Yakima Valley Transportation Co. The time period for these sample images ranged from 1945 to 1965. While some images would benefit from the use of digital editing, most images are good quality slides, have excellent color reproduction, good composition and clarity. Al was fortunate to record historic streetcars and interurbans in color at a time when black and white photography predominated.

## GN Day In Skykomish

The GNRHS and the Skykomish Historical Society are teaming with Sky Artworks to sponsor this year's Great Northern Day in Skykomish event on September 9, 2023. During the morning there will be presentations and displays followed by a Railfan Meet-Up, then the opening party for the art show themed "Light on the Rails" will begin.
